

President Planning and Policy Council (PPPC) Proposed Changes to be EffectivAY 2011-2012

The charge to the President's Planning and Policy Coisned follows:

It is the roleof President's Planning and Policy Council members to bring issues and ideas for policies to the group for discussion and recommendation to the President. The Council has oversight responsibility for developing the University's Strategic Plan and assessing Iniversity's progress toward meeting that plan as well as developing, reviewing, and ultimately recommending administrative policy to the President.

In accordance with the PPPG charge and purpose, it is proposed that three major changes to the Council format occur:

- 1) Give Councilmembers a larger role in the awareness and development of new policies assisting authors to vet draft policy;
 - x Charge policy authors with thresponsibility of vettingdraft policy across campus to all appropriate groups for feedback prior to the date the policy for recommendation.
 - x Charge Councihembers with discussing draft policies with other constituents across campus and bringing back thoughts and ideas. And bringing back thoughts and ideas. And bringing ideas/concerns forward assist authors in
 - x Councilmembers may also suggest the creation of new policy to the Council and the appropriate author will be determined.
 - x The PPPC is less or responsible for ensuring that policies are well coordinated and free of conflict as well as reviewing approved policies in accordance with Administrative Policy #OP.01.004.
